A. Thinking about LALC activity, can you give examples of your LALCs environmental work?

Some examples could include:

- Land and water management planning
- Fire management - cultural burning and bushfire mitigation
- Carbon offsets or carbon markets
- Biodiversity conservation (habitat and threatened species management, invasive species management, freshwater and sea Country management, land regeneration)
- Cultural heritage protection and maintenance
- Biosecurity monitoring
- Waste and stormwater management
- Education
- Ranger programs, stewardship activities and management of conservation lands (e.g. National park, Aboriginal area) and natural resources (e.g. water)
- *other activity...*

B. Thinking about your LALC land estate:

- Do you know how much of your land is zoned conservation?
- Do you know how much land could potentially be of biodiversity value or significance?
- Do you have biodiversity conservation work already underway on your LALC land?

C. Awareness and access to programs.

This section asks what programs you are aware of and that your LALC has participated.

- Are you aware of any programs that enable your LALC to participate in climate change mitigation or adaptation? Have you applied for, or expressed interest in any of these?
- Are you aware of the nature repair market? Carbon off set scheme? Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT)? Are you familiar with any other programs, grants, etc?
- Are you / your LALC, as Aboriginal landholders, aware of the Biodiversity Offsets Scheme and how the Scheme/market works?

If you are aware of the Biodiversity Offset Scheme:

- Have you considered participating in the biodiversity scheme? If not, why not?

- Are there any barriers that you think exist for your LALC to participating in the scheme, or ones you have experienced (e.g. awareness, knowledge, cost, uncertainty, lack of engagement)
- What changes, if any, could be made to support your LALC participation?

If you are unaware of the Scheme:

- Would this type of opportunity interest your LALC? How should the government engage with LALC's for this type of program?
