"They want the best for me and always can help and if they cant help me they get me someone who can e.g. doctor, driving instructor and so on."

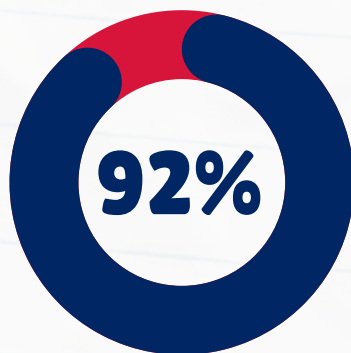

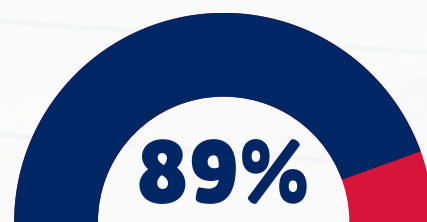
98% agree that their Community Connector is someone they can trust

93% agree that the people/services that the Community Connector has put them in touch with are helping



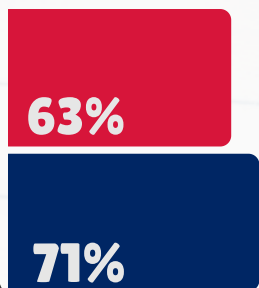
agree that they feel **culturally strong**

89% agree that they feel connected to their general community



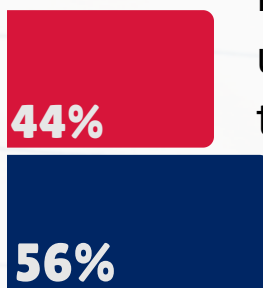
WHEN COMPARED TO THE STATE-WIDE TELL THEM FROM ME RESULTS, INDICATIONS ARE...
